The Fast-Attach® Two Tier Arm Set Instructions and Warranty Information

2 – Fast-Attach Two Tier Arms w/Memory Ring System

2 – Fast-Clamps

2 – Wire Management Clips



2 – Universal Clamp Spacer/Insert



Specifications:

- Adjustable height 3.5" – 13" (from surface to back of arms).
- Support arm length: 12.5"
- Weight capacity: maximum 40 lbs./pair

Warnings:

- **Only use the Fast-Attach Accessories with your devices over-hanging the table and not over-hanging the ground.**
- **Do not use the Fast-Clamp or Fast-Attach Accessories on any table except the Fastset® Utility Table.**

Installing your Fast-Attach® Accessory to the Fastset® Table

STEP 1: Position the Fast-Clamps on to the Fastset Table:

- Determine where you are going to locate your Fast-Attach Accessory and place the clamp on the table edge by squeezing it open & then releasing it into position - be sure the clamp is not located on a fastener on the underside of table (located approximately by small squares on picture below).
- **IMPORTANT:** If you are using your Fast-Attach Two Tier Arms on the sides or the far corners of the table, you **MUST** install the universal clamp spacer on to the Clamp prior to positioning it on the table.



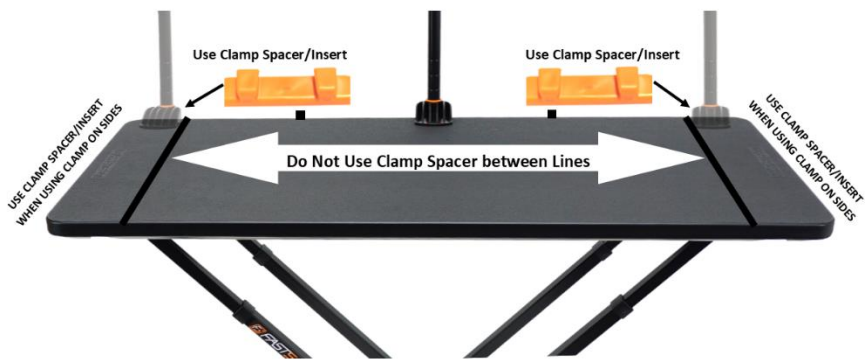
Spacer Installed

STEP 2: Insert the vertical post of your Fast-Attach Accessory:

Before inserting the vertical post, make sure the locking cam lever on the clamp is in the down position. Insert the vertical post through the clamp opening and send the accessory to your preferred height/position then push the cam lever up until it clicks into the locked position.

Using the Features on your Fast-Attach® Two Tier Arms

Installing the Two-Tier Arms to equal Heights using the Memory Ring feature:

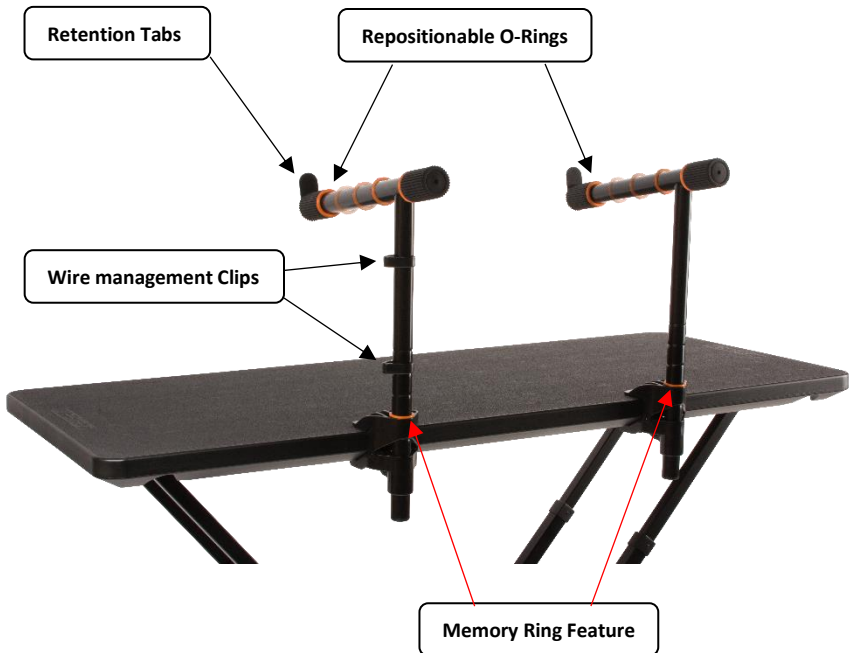
- Simply place the Memory Rings on both vertical post of your Two-Tier Arms at the same positions on each arm (in one of the 5 set groves). Insert each arm into the Fast-Clamp until the O-Ring meets the clamp.
- **Note:** O-Rings are for reference only, pushing the vertical post into the clamp too hard may cause the O-Ring to move out of the set groove. Should this happen, reposition the O-Ring back to the proper set groove before locking the Fast-Clamp.

Adjusting the repositionable O-Rings on the Support Arms for smaller devices:

- When using the Two-Tier Arms for smaller gear that doesn't reach the rear support boot on the arm (such as a laptop), you can reposition the front O-Ring up & down the support arm so your gear will rest on the O-Ring and not on the metal of the support arm.

Adjusting the Gear Retention Tabs:

- The gear retention tabs on the front of your Two-Tier Arms can be rotated in either direction, effectively lowering the height of the tab. This is desirable when using the Two-Tier Arms to support thinner gear (such as a laptop) so that the tabs won't interfere with your wrist.



Fast Set Supports Limited Warranty Details

Fast Set Supports, LLC, herein referred to as "Fast Set Supports", warranty obligations are limited to the terms set forth as follows:

- Fast Set Supports warrants all Fastset® Tables and Fast-Attach Line of Accessories to be free from manufacturing defects under normal use for a period of Three Years from the date of retail purchase by the original end-user purchaser.
- Fast Set Supports warrants all soft products, such as cases, scrimms, covers, etc. to be free from manufacturing defects under normal use for a period of One Year from the date of retail purchase by the original end-user purchaser.
- If the product is no longer manufactured by Fast Set Supports, and qualifies for repair under the warranty program, the product will be replaced with the closest comparable product as determined by Fast Set Supports.
- This warranty does not include damage to the product resulting from normal wear and tear, accident, misuse, improper installation or operation, or unauthorized repair or alterations.
- The Limited Warranty does not apply to any non-Fast Set Supports products or sub-brands even if packaged or sold with other products.
- Should the product become defective within the warranty provisions, Fast Set Supports will elect to repair or replace the product free of charge at our option, including free return postage, provided it is delivered prepaid to Fast Set Supports.
- Fast Set Supports may elect to send original end-user new or refurbished customer-installable replacement product or parts.
- Proof of purchase in the form of a dated receipt must be submitted with the returned product.
- All products needing to be sent to Fast Set Supports for repair or replacement must have a Return Authorization Number and will be returned to the sender un-repaired if one is not included. Please email your request (with explanation of problem) to Customer Support at support@fastsetusa.com for a Return Authorization Number and return instructions.
- It is the sender's responsibility to pay for shipment to Fast Set Supports.
- If the product is determined to fall under warranty, Fast Set Supports will pay for return shipping to the customer within the contiguous 48 states.
- If a replacement product or part is provided, the original product or part becomes the property of Fast Set Supports.

Should Fast Set Supports deem a product non-warranty, repair services or replacement parts may be available. Fast Set Supports will contact the sender with repair options.
